The League will declare the final order of finish as the web standings will not necessarily display the seedings properly. Final order of finish and seeded schedules will be posted to the website.

### Tiebreaker if teams are tied:

- Most points earned between the tied teams in head to head competition
- Most overall wins this season using all League games played
- Goal differential between the tied teams
- Fewest goals allowed between the tied teams
- Goal differential this season using all League games played
- Fewest Goals allowed this season using all League games played

Once a criteria firmly establishes the position of any tied team, that team will be placed in that position, and the remaining teams will start the tie breaking process from the beginning to determine the order of finish for the remaining teams.

- Players must have participated in a minimum of four (4) AYHL League games in order to be eligible to participate in the AYHL Playoffs.
- Your current AYHL web site roster should match your Certified USA Hockey Team Roster. ONLY those players and coaches listed on BOTH your USA Hockey roster and the AYHL web site roster will be permitted to participate in games, or be in the bench area. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule, as it is a USA Hockey liability issue. Please note that all player information must be complete on the AYHL web site. There will be fines imposed by the League for each missing piece of information at a rate no less than \$25.00 per occurrence.

- Please verify your team roster which will be posted outside the AYHL Playoff Office.
  - Verify players names and jersey numbers making any corrections/additions as necessary.
  - Scratch any players not participating for the entire weekend (prior to all remaining games please report any additional scratches or changes to the League Office).
  - Verify all Coaches who will be on the bench and Locker Room Monitors are listed on the roster.

There will be no “standings boards” with scores and advancing teams located on-site.
- Teams and players must be dressed and ready for their games 20 minutes prior to published schedule time.
- Games will not start prior to the published time due to broadcast scheduling.
- Live Barn will be broadcasting all AYHL Playoff Games. Standard rates for viewing games will apply. Save 10% with promo code AYHL-37F7. For additional information and to view games checkout [livebarn.com](http://livebarn.com)
- Carmo Photography will be on site for all Playoff photography.  
Photography sales will be available at the Ice Line Facility in the lobby area of Rinks 1&2.
- Merchandise will be available in the Pub lobby entrance near the Playoff Operations Office.
- All hotel accommodations are the responsibility of the individual teams. The league will not have provisions for securing hotel rooms at any venue.
- Scorekeeping will be the responsibility of the Ice Line Ice Staff. If Team Managers choose to be in the score keeping area they will be allowed providing they are properly rostered as per USA Hockey rules.
- Playoff game format will be the same as regular season games at each level (period length, penalties etc).
- All games (Round Robin, Single Game Elimination and Championship) played until a winner is determined per overtime procedures.

# AWARDS

## ALL PARTICIPANTS

- Players participating in the 2025 AYHL League Playoffs will receive a complimentary Playoff branded t-shirt.

## FIRST PLACE CHAMPIONS

- One hat with AYHL Playoff logo, division and win position for each player on first place team.
- One banner with AYHL Playoff logo, division and win position.
- Championship cup trophy awarded to the winner of the divisional Championship game at each level.

## FINALIST

- One banner with AYHL Playoff logo, division and position.

## ALL AMERICAN FORWARD AND DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

- Awarded to the most outstanding forward and defenseman (two trophies) in the final championship game at each level to be determined by a neutral third party league representative.

> *Recipient is not necessarily a player on the winning team and is at the discretion of the league representative.*

## GREAT AMERICAN GOALIE OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

- Awarded to the most outstanding goaltender in the final championship game at each level to be determined by a neutral third party league representative.

> *Recipient is not necessarily a player on the winning team and is at the discretion of the league representative.*

## TIE BREAKERS

- 1. The results of the head-to-head games played between the tied teams in the following order:**
  - a. Standings - Most points.
  - b. Most wins.
  - c. Differential - Subtracting goals scored against from goals scored in these games, the positions being determined in order of the greatest surplus.
  - d. Quotient - Dividing the goals scored in these games by the goals scored against, the positions being determined in order of the greatest quotient. A quotient involving dividing by zero (0) has a higher standing than a quotient from dividing by any other number other than zero (0). When two or more teams have no goals against and the quotient tiebreaker is required, the teams shall be ranked high to low in descending order of "goals for."
  
- 2. If after applying the formulas of 1 a, b, c, or d, the tie still exists, the results of all the games played by the teams tied in the following order:**
  - a. Most wins.
  - b. Differential - Subtracting goals scored against from goals scored in these games, the positions being determined in order of the greatest surplus.
  - c. Quotient - Dividing the goals scored in these games by the goals scored against, the positions being determined in order of the greatest quotient. A quotient involving dividing by zero (0) has higher standing than a quotient from dividing by any number other than zero. Where two or more teams have no goals against and the quotient tiebreaker is required, the teams shall be ranked high to low in descending order of "goals for."
  - d. Most periods won - In the games played by each tied team, points will be awarded for each regulation period won (2 points) and for each regulation period tied (1 point). Positions shall be in the order of highest point total.
  - e. Quickest first goal - The team that scored the quickest goal in their preliminary round games shall be ranked highest.

**NOTE: Forfeits** - If a team forfeits any of its games, and becomes involved in any tie breaking formulas to determine its eligibility to advance to the next level of play, the team forfeits all games in the round robin play and the games are recorded as 1-0 victory for the non-offending team.

# OVERTIME RULES

## ROUND ROBIN & SINGLE ELIMINATION GAMES

ALL GAMES PLAYED TO A WINNER

### 1) FIRST OVERTIME PERIOD

- Five minute sudden death overtime period, four on four.
- Two minute rest period at the end of third period of regulation play.
- Teams change ends.
- Penalties from the third period will carry over into the overtime period.
- Timeout permitted during overtime period providing it was not used in regulation time.
- If a team receives a penalty in overtime, the teams will play 4 on 3. If the same team is assessed a second penalty before the first one expires, then the teams will play 4 on 2.

### 2) SECOND OVERTIME PERIOD

- Ice resurface, all levels.
- Five minute sudden death overtime period, three on three.
- Teams change ends.
- Penalties from the period will carry over into the overtime period.
- Timeout permitted during overtime period providing it was not used in regulation time.
- If a team receives a penalty in overtime, the teams will play 3 on 2. If the same team is assessed a second penalty before the first one expires, then the teams will play 3 on 1.

### 3) SHOOTOUT

- A shootout is defined as a player attempting to score a goal and the opposing goalkeeper attempting to stop the shooter from scoring the goal.
- The home team shall have the choice whether his/her team will shoot first or second.
- All goalkeepers and all players from both teams listed on the official game sheet shall be eligible to participate in the shootout.
- No goalkeepers may shoot in the shootout.
- The goalkeepers will defend the net they were defending in the 3rd period.
- Any penalized player whose penalty had not been completed when the overtime period ended or who receives a penalty during a shootout procedure is not eligible to participate in any portion of the shootout procedure(s) and must remain in the penalty box.
- The shootout procedure shall begin with five (5) different individual shooters from each team taking alternate shots. The players do not need to be named beforehand.
- The goalkeepers from each team may be changed after each shot.
- The players of both teams will take the shots alternately.
- If after the shootout, the shootout score is still tied, there will be a sudden death shootout.
- The official scorekeeper shall record all shots taken indicating the players, goalkeepers and goals scored.

# OVERTIME RULES

## CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES

**ALL GAMES PLAYED TO A WINNER**

### 1) FIRST OVERTIME PERIOD

- Regulation sudden death overtime period, five on five.
- Two minute rest period at the end of third period of regulation play.
- Teams change ends.
- Penalties from the third period will carry over into the overtime period.
- Timeout permitted during overtime period providing it was not used in regulation time.

### 2) SECOND OVERTIME PERIOD

- Ice resurface.
- Regulation sudden death overtime period, four on four.
- Teams change ends.
- Penalties from the previous overtime period will carry over into this overtime period.
- Timeout permitted during overtime period providing it was not used in previous overtime time period.

**> If teams remain tied after the second overtime period as outlined above, repeat first and second overtime period procedures above until a winner is determined. There will be no shoot out in Championship games.**

# AWARDING OF POINTS

Each team will be awarded three points for a win in regulation, two points for a win in overtime or shootout, one point for a loss in overtime or shootout and zero points for a loss in regulation.

<b>Win Regulation</b>	<b>3 Points</b>
<b>Win Following Tie</b>	<b>2 Points</b>
<b>Loss Following Tie</b>	<b>1 Points</b>
<b>Loss Regulation</b>	<b>0 Points</b>

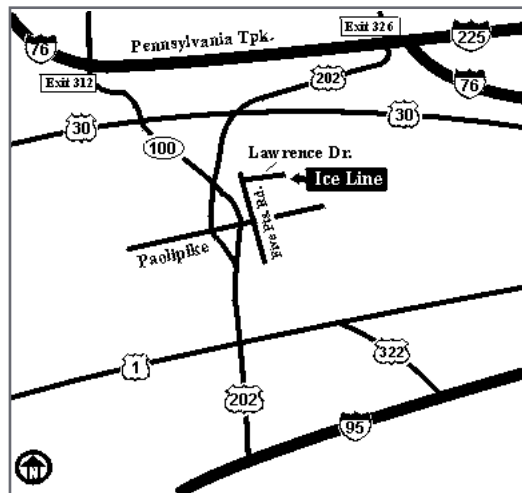
